- 0 **no neglect**
- mild neglect: always exploring right hemi-space first, going slowly and hesitatingly toward the left, and showing occasional left-sided omissions (score 1-10)
- 2 moderate neglect: showing clear and constant left-sided omissions or collisions (score 11-20)
- 3 **severe neglect**: totally unable to explore the left hemispace (score 21-30)
