### Rating Scale

- 0     **no neglect**
- 1     **mild neglect:** always exploring right hemi-space first, going slowly and hesitatingly toward the left, and showing occasional left-sided omissions (score 1-10)
- 2     **moderate neglect:** showing clear and constant left-sided omissions or collisions (score 11-20)
- 3     **severe neglect:** totally unable to explore the left hemispace (score 21-30)

### Items

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1.     Forgets to groom or shave the left part of face
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2.     Experiences difficulty in adjusting left sleeve or slipper
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3.     Forgets to eat food on the left side of plate
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4.     Forgets to clean the left side of mouth after eating
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5.     Experiences difficulty in looking towards the left
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6.     Forgets about a left part of the body (ex: forgets to put UE on armrest, foot on footplate)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7.     Has difficulty paying attention to noise or people addressing from the left
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8.     Collides with people or objects on left side such as doors or furniture while walking or driving wheelchair
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9.     Experiences difficulty finding way to the left when traveling in familiar places or in the rehab unit
- \_\_\_\_\_ 10.    Experiences difficulty finding personal belongings in the room or bathroom when they are on the left side
