### Test Items, Test Manual, and Care Instructions

#### **Care Instructions**

Hold the test charts by their edges to keep the chart surfaces clean and prevent natural oils on your fingers from degrading the print on the charts. Use the soft tipped pointer to touch the print on the charts. Store the test charts in the carrying case after use to keep the surface of the charts free of dirt. Use warm water and a soft cloth to wipe off the front of the charts. Use only non-abrasive, mild petroleum free dish detergent to clean smudges off of the chart surfaces. **DO NOT** use disinfectant to clean the charts. **DO NOT** scrub the front surface of the charts.
